REQUIREMENTS

All undergraduate students with a MIS concentration are eligible for the scholarship. The scholarship money is provided by student fees and generous donations to SMIS. Scholarships will be presented during the Fall Recruiting Dinner on **Thursday, September 18th**. Below are the scholarship requirements and selection criteria.

General Requirements:

Completed applications must be submitted by **September 1st at 5:00pm**

All scholarship winners must commit to attend the SMIS Fall Recruiting Dinner on September 18th. *You must be present to receive the scholarship.*

Selection Criteria:

Scholarship decisions will be based on the consideration of:

- (1) Student GPA, minimum of a 3.0 Major GPA
- (2) Student involvement and/or leadership in MIS activities at the University, College, or Departmental level, extracurricular activities, or work experience.

*Note that if you have previously received a scholarship from SMIS, you are not eligible for another.

Completed applications should be submitted to Clay Roberts by September 1st at any regularly scheduled SMIS meeting. Applications can also be submitted to Meredith Dewald in the MIS Departmental office (Brooks 312).
